

The show ran from the 19th to the 23rd of March, at Manfield park in Fielding. The show runs both New Zealand and American classes, this year judged by Jake Hartman from the USA.

The programme includes open feature classes, futurities, and a novelty trail. On the Wednesday morning, the show also welcomed English judge Debbie Hirini to judge the classical english classes for the show - dressage, paced and mannered, and rider classes.

Our team very much enjoyed the experience. The horses travelled and performed amazing, with all of us attaining personal achievements. I was fortunate enough to win two classes - amateur working western rail and open paced & mannered hack, as well as several other great placings, including 6th in a strongly contested open ranch riding.
